Missap prevails in \$75,000 Green Carpet Stakes

Missap and jockey Dean Sarvis used come-from-behind tactics to capture the \$75,000 Green Carpet Stakes on a beautiful Sunday afternoon, May 27 at Belterra Park.

The 3-year-old Ohio-registered daughter of A.P. Warrior stole the show in the final yards by overtaking the leading Buster's Boy (Walter De La Cruz) in the one and one-sixteenth mile contest over the Belterra turf to prevail by half a length as the even-money public's choice in a modest clocking of 1:42.56.

Missap was bred and is owned by the Beckett Team LLC, and conditioned by Kellyn Gorder with three wins in nine lifetime starts and a career bankroll of \$186,368. She is now a multiple stakes winner, having captured the \$150,000 Galbreath Stakes on Best of Ohio day last fall at Belterra.

Missap was also the lone distaff in the field of eight in the Green Carpet.

Forewarned (Carlos Villasana) picked up place money, with **Deer Creek Road** (Yuri Yaranga) third and **Buckeye Kitten** (John McKee) fourth.
