True Cinder victorious in \$75,000 Mackey-Angenora

True Cinder and jockey Geraldo Corrales left no doubt they were much the best as they cruised to a near seven-length triumph in the \$75,000 Michael G. Mackey Angenora Stakes, on June 2 at JACK Thistledown.

The field of ten was reduced to seven Ohio-registered, fillies and mares, 3-year-olds and up, after three of the contestants were scratched in the 26th running of the six-furlong sprint.

True Cinder, a 4-year-old Alcindor filly, out of the Shakespeare mare Be True, left the gate alertly and quickly took command of the race, besting rivals La Nina Bronca (Christian Pilates), third-place finisher Mayas Queen Neetee (Scott Spieth) and fourth-place finisher School Board Prez (Dean Sarvis) with little effort. She was clocked in a respectable 1:10.22.

Conditioned and owned by Mike Rone, True Cinder now has \$349,300 in career earnings, from seven career wins, with five second and two thirds in 15 starts.

Bred by Larry Byer, True Cinder's other triumphs include: the \$75,000 Horizon Stakes in 2017; the \$75,000 Cincinnati in 2017; the \$75,000 Classen Memorial in 2017; and the 2016 edition of the \$75,000 Glacial Princess.
