OHIO STATE RACING COMMISSION

RESOLUTION 2024-03

WHEREAS, The Ohio State Racing Commission ("Commission") has the authority under Ohio Revised Code 3769.03 to prescribe rules and conditions under which horse racing may be conducted;

WHEREAS, The Commission is allowed to refer to the guidelines and recommended penalties within the "Racing Commissioners International Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances And Recommended Penalties Model Rule";

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Administrative Code 3769-01 the Commission may, by order, establish a system of classification of prohibited foreign substances, to include methods of detection and/or regulatory thresholds thereof, recommended penalties and disciplinary measures for the presence of said substances in test samples. In determining the substances to be so classified, the commission shall give due consideration to the uniform classification guidelines of foreign substances and recommended penalties and model rules as revised from time to time by the Association of Racing Commissioners International Inc.

WHEREAS, if the commission has promulgated an independent threshold list for therapeutic, endogenous, dietary, environmental and/or androgenic-anabolic steroids these levels would supersede the Association of Racing Commissioners International Inc. Guidelines.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AND ORDERED, the Commission formally adopts the "Racing Commissioners International Uniform Classification Guidelines for Foreign Substances And Recommended Penalties Model Rule" as revised from time to time. Be it further resolved that the Commission may consider and use the guidelines as appropriate.
